Thank you for enquiring about Black Hawk 3. This is the second European training camp presented by Racing TNT. We will be based in Playa de Palma, Mallorca, Espana. at the Hotel Ayrón Park. We will be working closely with our local advisor Doug Petty, who has been working with cycling groups on the island for 40 years. Mallorca is a popular training destination for cyclists. A good climate and smooth roads make it a very easy place to cycle.

What is on Offer

We offer one week of training with at least two BTF coaches. The sessions have been designed to make the most of the facilities. The week is based around the cycling sessions with some recovery runs and early morning open water swims..

General Information

Playa de Palma is a long beach (3km long) South East of Palma about 5 km from the airport. It is a

long strip of hotels and bars and apartments that runs between the defined towns Can Pastilla and El Arenal. The resort is populated by German tourists with some English and some French as well as Spanish holiday makers. The area is well served by bars and restaurants with some notable Italian restaurants around the church. navigation is complex and it is wise to note the number of the nearest beach bar, these Balineros are numbered from 1 to 15 along the entire front. The bay is sandy and extremely sheltered, with calm water almost every day. A bus service runs to and from Palma cathedral every 15 minutes.

Climate

Average afternoon air temperature is 24 Celsius in April and sea water temperature is 14 Celsius. Night time air temperature is 14 Celsius.

Other Bike Shops and Rental

There are a number of bike hire options in the local resort, charging around 20 Euro per day (approximately £16 based on an exchange rate of 1.28) with varying deposits. Please note that smaller frame sizes are difficult to source, these would be size 48cm and under. (This is commonly the seat tube length in a frame with a horizontal top tube, or the top tube length.) There are a couple of hire services outside of the resort which offer a delivery service, this will usually add about 40 Euro to the costs of hire.
